- pays a little money (450€ a month / Minijob),

- brings you in contact with fellow researchers, and
- offers you the opportunity to support and participate in civil / homeland security research.

You should be studying economics, political science, or a related discipline, have an interest in security issues and speak fluent English and/or German.
